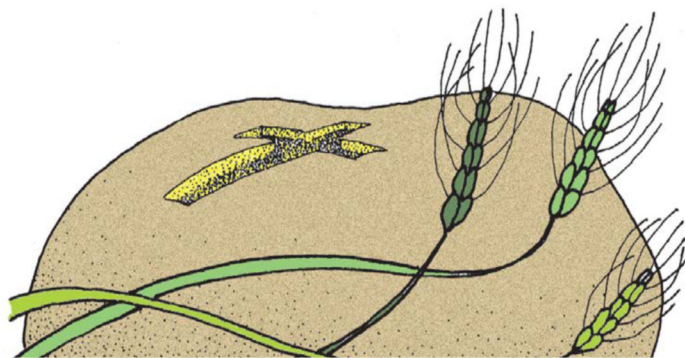

Becoming Catholic

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

In Isaiah 43:1 God says: **“I have called you by name, you are mine.”** The invitation to respond to God’s call is extended to anyone who is interested in becoming Catholic or exploring Catholicism as a way of life.

At St. Mary's becoming Catholic is a process coordinated by a group of fully initiated Catholics who make up the RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) team. The team includes lay people, deacons, and priests. This process may be for you:

If you have not been baptized.

Or you have been baptized in another faith.

Or you have been baptized Catholic but have not completed full initiation into the Church through Confirmation and/or Eucharist.

Maybe you attend Mass regularly but do not participate in full communion by reception of the Sacrament of the Eucharist.

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the process established for the universal Church for individuals to become Catholic and receive the sacraments of initiation—Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist. This initiation process also involves a parish community experiencing a renewal in faith as it prepares and welcomes new members into the Church.

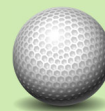
