TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

The origins of today's solemnity lie in thirteenth-century Belgium. In those days, people seldom received Holy Communion, and never from the chalice. A nun in a troubled convent, Juliana of Liège, devoted her life to stirring up love for the Eucharist, lobbying for a feast day to honor the Blessed Sacrament with Masses and processions.

Juliana may have been inspired by the Ascension Day processions in nearby Bruges. Crusaders brought a treasure home to Bruges from Constantinople in 1204: a reliquary said to contain a cloth from Joseph of Arimathea with which he had helped prepare the body of Jesus for burial. The stain on the cloth was said to be the holy blood itself, and so the people of Bruges built a great basilica to house the relic. Bruges became a great center of pilgrimage because of this treasure, and the procession of the Holy Blood is still one of the greatest festivals in Belgium today. The bishop carries the relic through the narrow streets, and the people wear medieval costumes and act out scenes from the Bible.

Welcome to our Summer Seminarian
Craig Kursinsky



I would like to take this opportunity to thank everyone whom I have met so far at St. Mary of the Assumption for their warm welcome, I already feel like part of the family. I would also like to introduce myself to everyone that I have not yet had a chance to meet. My name is Craig Kursinsky, and I am a seminarian studying for the Diocese of Wilmington. It was only three years ago that I was a parishioner at Holy Cross in Dover, and now by God's grace I find myself at St. Mary of the Assumption.

While I do not want to overwhelm you with the details of my life, it seems appropriate to give a short summary of my vocation and life story. I was born in Pontiac Township, MI (a suburb of Detroit). A few years after high school, I enlisted in the Air Force. While on active duty, I was stationed at Dover AFB, DE, twice. Once my enlistment was over, I returned to Michigan and eventually earned my bachelor's degree in civil engineering from Western Michigan University. The first and only job I had after becoming an engineer was in Dover, DE, where I worked for the Delaware Department of Transportation. It was during those eight years in Dover, during the time I spent as a parishioner at Holy Cross, that I began to discern a possible call to the priesthood. I have now completed three years of studies at St. Mary's Seminary and University in Baltimore, MD. Last summer I was at St. Elizabeth's in Wilmington, and the summer before that, I was at St. John the Beloved.

I am looking forward to spending the summer here. I hope to have a chance to get to know everyone at St. Mary of the Assumption. When you see me around, feel free to say hello. I expect that my time here will be valuable in my ongoing discernment and formation. I would ask for your prayers for all of the seminarians studying for the Diocese of Wilmington, and I will keep you in mine.

We are celebrating our STAR Assessment results; students have made huge growth in both Reading and Math. We recognized students at each grade level who made the most growth in Reading and in Math as well as the classes that had the top average growth in each subject area! In Reading, 72% of our students are at or above proficiency with a Student Percentile Growth of 62%. This indicates that our children have made 62% greater growth than their national peers. Both the Reading and Math scores, place our students in the High Achievement, High Growth Category in Reading. Math scores are comparable.
