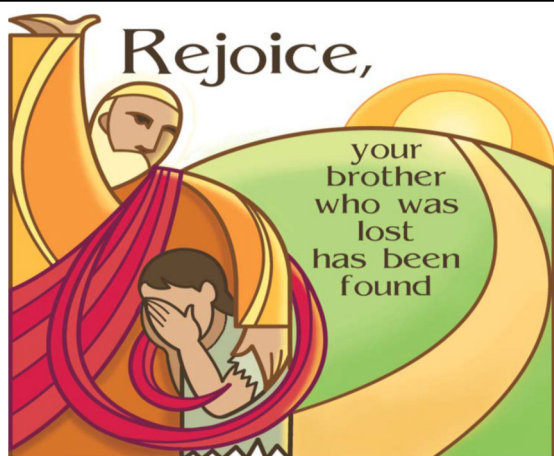

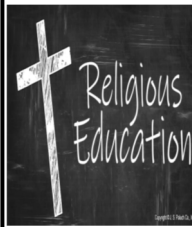

DRINKING WATER FOR VILLAGERS IN INDIA FUNDRAISER

".....for when I was thirsty you gave me to drink, come enter the home of my father..."

Three villages in Fr. Clement's Holy Spirit parish in a poor, drought-stricken area of S. India lack a resource for drinking water and need bore-wells or salt water purifiers and rain harvesting tanks. The water is presently trucked in. Also the toilets in the primary school are in a terrible state and need to be replaced. Finally, one village is 7 miles from the Parish Center and there is no public transportation so the people have to walk for Sunday worship. Hence he needs a chapel built there. Fr. Clement's total needs are \$20,000. The film "Pope Francis – a man of his word" will be shown at St Mark's Auditorium, 2501 Pike Creek Rd., Wilmington, DE 19808 on September 15th at 3pm. 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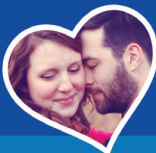


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
