


Part 7 - Ways to Boost the Belief in the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in The Holy Eucharist

Four of the most incredible Eucharistic miracles that have been examined by top scientists around the world, who ultimately concluded that science could not explain the miraculous phenomenon.

C. Buenos Aires, Argentina On August 18, 1996, as Fr. Alejandro Pezet concluded Mass at the parish of Santa María y Caballito Almagro, a woman reported that a consecrated host had been desecrated on a candle holder in the back of the church. Unable to consume the Host, Fr. Pezet placed it in a dish of water and stored it in the tabernacle. The following Monday, the priest opened the tabernacle and found the host appeared to be a bloody substance. The miracle was reported to Cardinal Jorge Bergoglio (the future Pope Francis), who led an investigation into the miracle after the bloody host was miraculously preserved for several years.

According to the magazine *Milujcie się!*, "On October 5, 1999, in the presence of the Cardinal's representatives, scientist Dr. Ricardo Castañón Gómez took a sample of the bloody fragment and sent it to New York for analysis."

The event does not have a natural explanation.


