THE HOPE AND PROMISE OF REDEMPTION

The prophet Jeremiah prophesies the end of the Babylonian exile. He describes how the weak and sorrowful people now return with joy. These are the scattered people of God: the blind and the lame, the mothers and pregnant women. They shall be led along an easy road so that no one will stumble. The Lord's kindness and mercy are on all these weak and broken people.

Here and in Psalm 126 we find the most lovely poetic images of God's love and care for us. "Those that sow in tears / shall reap rejoicing. Although they go forth weeping, / carrying the seed to be sown, / they shall come back rejoicing, / carrying their sheaves" (Psalm 126:5-6). Although God had to punish Israel for their many sins, God never forgot them, scattered as they were, and brings them all back to the land of their ancestors, there to flourish and be joyful again. We can see in this the hope and the promise of our own redemption, gathered from the far corners of the earth into the great banquet of God.

I humbly ask forgiveness of the millions of women and unborn babies who have experienced the violence of abortion. In this place of healing, the National Memorial for the Unborn, I stand with those who honor the worth of every unborn child as created in the image of God. I will strive, in the name of Jesus, to end this holocaust."

It should be noted that Norma never had an abortion! Her baby was given up for adoption. Norma worked tirelessly to pray and speak against the evils and horror of abortion until she died February 18, 2017.

Did you Know?

How to Contemplate God in Prayer – Part 1

Contemplation in the Catholic tradition is a rich form of prayer that sounds much more complicated than it actually is. In fact, it is a type of prayer that is focused on simplicity and not complexity. The Catechism of the Catholic Church quotes St. Theresa of Avila when describing contemplative prayer: "Contemplative prayer in my opinion is nothing else than a close sharing between friends; it means taking time frequently to be alone with him who we know loves us." (CCC2709).

Generally speaking there are no formulas to follow in contemplative prayer. It is the "prayer of the child of God" and the "simplest expression of the mystery of prayer" (CCC 2712-2113). Contemplative prayer is centered in listening to the voice of God, whether it be in the Word of scripture or in the movements of the heart. It is most often done in silence during a time dedicated to contemplation. It requires a great deal of humility and patience, trusting fully in God's presence, whether or not you hear his voice in your soul. Phillip Kosloski

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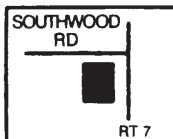
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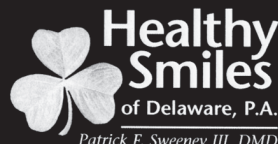
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
