Fr. Brian S. Lewis was ordained a priest for the Diocese of Wilmington on June 8, 2013. In the past five years, he has been parochial vicar at St. John the Beloved and St. Elizabeth parishes. Presently, he serves at St. Joseph on the Brandywine parish as parochial vicar and chairs the Annual Marian Pilgrimage for the Diocese of Wilmington. He has a deep devotion to Our Lady, whom he calls "the Womb of my vocation," and his spirituality is formed after the example of St. Joseph, St. John the Baptist, St. Francis of Assisi, and St. Therese of Lisieux. He has led several parish Lenten missions throughout the Diocese of Wilmington and spoken at Diocesan events such as 40 Days for Life and for Catholic organizations such as the Diocese of Wilmington's branch of Legatus. Prior to ordination to the Priesthood of Jesus Christ, Fr. Lewis was a high school French teacher for some fifteen years.

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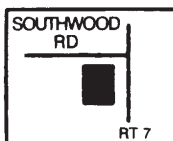
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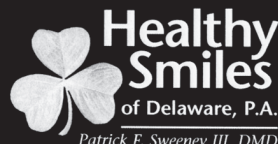

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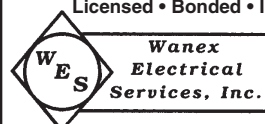
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
